

## **LIFETIME FITNESS PARTNERSHIP**

In 2000, the City of Champlin and Lifetime Fitness established one of the first of its kind public-private partnership. The collaboration requires that Champlin Lifetime Fitness offer Champlin residents access to their first-rate recreational facility at a reduced daily fee. Champlin residents do not need to be a member to use Lifetime's facilities. Since opening, the relationship between Lifetime Fitness and the City of Champlin has served as a model for cities nationwide seeking to build a *privatized* community center.

The 60,000 square foot fitness center, adjacent to the Champlin Ice Forum, is privately owned and operated by Lifetime Fitness. It includes an indoor pool, two gyms, aerobics room, and over 100 pieces of cardiovascular equipment and training machines.

### **Lifetime Fitness Daily Passes**

Champlin residents can use the facilities at Lifetime Fitness without being a member of the club. To access the facilities as a non-member, residents must purchase a daily pass which is available at a reduced rate.

### **Reduced Daily Pass Fees**

The following daily fees are reduced and only available to Champlin residents.

Age (years)	Pool & Gym	Entire Center
0 - 11	\$1	NA
12-17	3	5
18 – 59	6	8
60 and older	1	3
Family (3 or more)	10	15

### **Photo Identification Required**

If you are 18 years or older and purchasing a daily pass, you must present photo identification to gain admission to Life Time Fitness. If you are younger than 18 years, you must present your school ID. There are no exceptions to this requirement.

### **Daily Pass Hours**

Residents may purchase and use daily passes any day from 6:00 a.m. – 9:00 p.m.
