Local musician Anderson Daniels will kick off the MC Summer Series and Father Hennepin Festival weekend with a free performance on June 6 at 6 p.m. There will also be a preshow tailgate with the Mayor and City Council that evening, including food trucks and beverage vendors. In July, Mississippi Crossings will be the home of the Champlin Farmers Market on Tuesdays from 2-6 p.m. MC also offers pontoon rentals through Your Boat Club all summer long. Spend a day taking in the scenic views using the 20% resident discount code **champlinresident20**. New this summer, Jensen's Market will open at the Crossings with grab-and-go items for the first time, and Cullen's Ice Cream will return with sweet treats. Additionally, a riverside restaurant is on the way.

With all the joys of having a pet, one of the not-so-glamorous aspects of having one is cleaning up after them. If we leave pet waste uncollected, not only is it unsightly but can cause unsanitary conditions with detrimental effects on human health and the environment.

When pet waste is washed into our waterways, it depletes oxygen levels and releases ammonia and excess nutrients, all of which contribute to unsightly weeds and algal blooms while harming fish and other aquatic organism populations. It also contains pathogenic bacteria and other parasites leading to health issues such as increased levels of Escherichia coli (E. coli) making lakes and rivers unsafe for swimming and other recreational activities.

Remember, it is important to take time at home to properly dispose of your pet's waste and to bring along equipment like doggy bags to clean up when you're on the go. It is up to us to ensure our local waters remain clean, healthy, and safe. [City Code 10-14 Animal Waste]

Watering Restrictions

The odd-even sprinkling ordinance is in effect through Labor Day. Do your part to conserve water by restricting sprinkling to every other day and only between 7 p.m. and 10 a.m. The first violation will result in a written warning. The second and subsequent violations will result in an excess usage fee of \$75/day.



State Primary Election – August 13 (7 a.m. to 8 p.m.)

What is a primary election?

A primary election determines which candidates will be on the ballot in the November general election.

Partisan offices

Partisan offices will list a political party next to a candidate's name on the ballot. This includes all state and federal offices. You can only vote for one political party.

Nonpartisan offices

Nonpartisan offices will not list a political party next to a candidate's name on the ballot. For example, county, city, and school board offices are nonpartisan. You can vote for any candidate in any of the offices on your ballot.

What is on the ballot?

The ballot will contain all state and federal offices requiring a primary, except the president and vice president. Offices that may appear on the State Primary ballot in August include U.S. Senator, U.S. Representative, and State Representative.

View a sample ballot

Sample ballots are available beginning 46 days before each election at city hall or online.

Where do I vote?

Your polling location may have changed due to redistricting that took place in 2022. Remember, you must vote based on the address where you maintain residence. Your polling location will be open on Election Day from 7 a.m. - 8 p.m.

- **Ward 1 – Precinct 1:** Mississippi Crossings Event Center, 307 E. River Pkwy.
- **Ward 2 – Precinct 1:** Champlin Ice Forum, 12165 Ensign Avenue N.
- **Ward 3 – Precinct 1:** Servant of Christ Lutheran Church, 740 East Hayden Lake Rd.
- **Ward 4 – Precincts 1 and 2:** Jackson Middle School, 6000 109th Avenue N.

Early voting

Avoid the lines on Election Day and vote early through the Absentee Ballot process:

- Early (absentee) voting for the Primary Election will be available at City Hall from **June 28 to August 12**.
- If you are unable to absentee vote, complete an Absentee Ballot Application online and then fax, email, or mail it to Hennepin County Elections.

Have trouble making it to the polls?

If you want to receive a paper ballot before each election in Minnesota, you can sign up for the Minnesota Recurring Absentee Ballot Application.

Interested in running for Ward 3 or 4 councilmember?

The seats for Ward 3 and 4 will be up for election on November 5. The filing of candidates for these seats will be open from July 30 to August 13. These four-year terms will start in January 2025.



Backyard Chickens

City Council adopted an ordinance that allows up to four hens on single-family properties >12,000 sq. ft. and up to six on >0.5-acre plots. Permits are valid for two years with renewal fees of \$50. The initial fee is \$300. Permit covers review, site inspection, and first-year inspection. Hens must be well cared for and housed humanely. Permits may be revoked for noncompliance.

City Code:

- Only on single-family residential property
- No more than four chickens on property greater than 12,000 square feet
- No more than six chickens on parcels greater than 0.5 acres
- No roosters
- No processing on the property
- Chickens over six weeks old cannot be kept inside
- Chickens are not to roam free



Coop & Run Requirements:

- In the rear yard only
- At least 20 feet from the adjacent property
- At least 10 feet from the side or rear lot lines
- Architecturally appropriate building materials
- Fully enclosed coop and run
- Must comply with all city building and zoning codes

What Does the Flag Mean?

Flags are indicators that someone in the area is planning to dig, and they have marked the location of buried utility lines that correspond to specific utility types. The color code system has been devised to make it easy to identify which utility is located in the proposed area. This helps to prevent damage to underground utilities and the disruption of essential services.

Know the Color Code	
WHITE:	Proposed Excavation
PINK:	Temporary Survey Markings
RED:	Electric Power Lines, Cables, Conduit and Lighting Cables
YELLOW:	Gas, Oil, Steam, Petroleum or Gaseous Materials
ORANGE:	Communication, Alarm or Signal Lines, Cables or Conduit
BLUE:	Potable Water
PURPLE:	Reclaimed Water, Irrigation and Slurry Lines
GREEN:	Sewer and Drain Lines

It is crucial to preserve and maintain the location of flags. Residents shouldn't mow over or remove the flags. Please call 811 regarding the removal of flags.

If you plan to dig, contact 811 (GSOC), at least 48 hours before you begin, excluding weekends and holidays. Submit a request ticket by visiting Gopher State One Call at gopherstateonecall.org.
