



## *2023 Watercraft Slip Lottery Rules*

- The mayor or acting mayor will draw the names of the contest registrants at the City Council meeting on April 24, 2023, in Council Chambers. Winners need not be present to win.
- To be eligible to register, one must be 18 years of age and a resident of the City of Champlin.
- There is only to be allowed one registration per household and proof of residency will be required at the time of the lease signing between the lottery winning contestant and the City.
- Only one watercraft slip will be allowed for each chosen lessee.
- The moored watercraft at the watercraft slip will need to be registered in the lessee's name or spouse's name (must provide a copy of the license at lease signing).
- The watercraft slip lease is non-transferable (agreements will be completed at time of payment).
- Moored watercraft will need to be 25' or less in length.
- Moored watercraft can be a pontoon, fishing boat, or ski/wake boat.
- Eligibility contingent upon proof of insurance, maintaining insurance and a signed lease agreement.
- Lessee will be required to pay the lease fee (\$2,300) by April 15, 2023, for the first season and renew the lease fee in the second season no later than February 1, in 2024. If payment is not made by April 15, 2023, in first year, another registrant will be chosen from the lottery entries.
- Lease season terms will run for two consecutive seasons from May of 2023 (weather permitting install) to October 31<sup>st</sup> of each year for both 2023 and 2024. Leases terminate at the end of the second season on November 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Lessees must theft proof their own watercraft. The City will not be responsible for stolen or vandalized watercraft.
- Lessees must store trailers on property other than Mississippi Crossings property.
- Lessees are subject to all other rules and provisions in the agreement with the City.
- Lessees can cancel their leases after year/season one, but all payments are non-refundable. The payment for season two is non-refundable after payment is made in February 1, 2024.

## *2023 Watercraft Slip Lottery Rules cont'd.*

- Registrations are taken on the City's Park and Recreation Software for transparency and archival purposes. Names can be withdrawn from the lottery up until March 20, 2023.
- Lessee payments can be made at the Parks and Public Works Department.
- Lessees must agree to sign and abide by the lease agreement before being allowed to utilize the watercraft slip.
- Champlin Staff and City Council members are not eligible to enter the lottery.
- Lessees must maintain Champlin residency to be eligible for a second-year renewal.
- City provided watercraft I.D. must always be on the designated registered watercraft.
- Lessees are only allowed to use and moor to their assigned watercraft slip number.
- The last day to register for the free online lottery is April 14, 2023, at 11:59 p.m.
