
Discussion Continued – The City Planner stated that at the July 14, 2025, City Council meeting, the Northwest Area Comprehensive Plan Amendment was tabled to allow the Council additional time to discuss after hearing the feedback of the public and Planning Commission. The Council is asked to discuss the potential of allowing slab-on-grade villa-style homes in addition to walkout and lookout homes within the study area. She reviewed the site constraints and the proposed approach for integrating villas into the development guidelines. There was discussion related to the pros and cons of allowing both housing types and as well as the key points for discussion found within the staff report.
