Annual Presentation Regarding MS4 Program	<p><u>Special Presentations</u></p> <p>Environmental Specialist Touney explained that the City of Champlin is currently authorized to discharge stormwater under the permit referred to as the Small Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) General Permit under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES)/State Disposal System (SDS) permit administered by the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA). This permit was reissued to the City on September 30, 2021, and expires on November 15, 2025. The City is required to conduct a public meeting to educate the public and allow citizens an opportunity to comment on the existing Storm Water Pollution Prevention Program (SWPPP) and the progress toward reaching the required measurable goals of the permit. Touney conducted the annual review.</p>

Councilmember Moe asked if the City is in the process of applying for a new permit, as the current permit will soon expire.

Touney confirmed that the City has applied for the permit, but the MPCA has not yet released the new permit.

Councilmember LaCroix commented that he visited Night to Unite parties with Touney, and he did a great job interacting with residents, answering questions, and is a great asset to the City.

Overview of Worksession Discussion

The City Administrator provided a brief overview of the discussion that occurred earlier in the evening at the Council Worksession regarding:

- The Council began a discussion of a revised Assessment Policy, noting that the policy had not been updated since 2003. That discussion will continue after the Council meeting.
- The Council discussed potential amendments to accessory structure size regulations.
- After the Council meeting, the Council will discuss the process related to filling the upcoming Council vacancy.

Consent Agenda

Councilmember Moe requested to pull Item 9.5, Approve Change Order No. 1 for Goose Lake Parkway and Elm Creek Trail Area, Improvement Project No. 22502, from the Consent Agenda for further discussion.

Mayor Sabas requested to pull Items 9.1, Approve Proclamation Designating October as Domestic Violence Awareness Month in Champlin and Item 9.10, Authorize the Purchase of a New Backstop for Andrews Park Diamond No. Five, from the Consent Agenda for further discussion.

Approve Proclamation Designating October as Domestic Violence Awareness Month in Champlin Motion

Mayor Sabas read the proclamation aloud.

Motion by Councilmember Moe and seconded by Councilmember Truesdell to approve the proclamation designating October as Domestic Violence Awareness Month in Champlin. Voting in favor were Mayor Sabas, Councilmembers Tesdall, Moe, Truesdell and LaCroix. Voting against: none. Motion carried.

Approval of Joint Powers Agreement (JPA Between Champlin Police Department and Hennepin County for The Embedded Social Worker Position Motion

Motion by Councilmember LaCroix and seconded by Councilmember Truesdell to enter into a Joint Powers Agreement with Hennepin County for contracted full-time services of a social worker assigned to the Police Department. Mayor Sabas stated that this is an unexpected cost and had concerns that this improvement will only stop about 66 percent of the foul balls. He understood that a netting system would be about \$200,000, but also did not want to spend money that would not fix the problem. He asked if the proposed chain link system could be added to in the future to provide more height coverage.

City Administrator Max was unsure and noted that this item could be tabled in order to gain that additional data. She explained that they had funds available in the budget, and this project would be an improvement of the current situation.

Mayor Sabas asked if there have been discussions with Champlin Park Baseball, as they are a main user of the field and would perhaps contribute towards the cost.

The City Administrator noted that there have been discussions about potential cost-sharing of the project to some degree.

Mayor Sabas stated that he would prefer to table this to get more information.

Motion by Councilmember Truesdell and seconded by Councilmember Tesdall to continue consideration of the purchase of a new backstop for diamond number 5 at Andrews Park and direct

staff to investigate options and cost-share options. Voting in favor were Mayor Sabas, Councilmembers Tesdall, Moe, Truesdell and LaCroix. Voting against: none. Motion carried.

Finance Director Johnson stated that in accordance with Minnesota Statute 444.075, the City may certify unpaid utility charges to Hennepin County for collection with property taxes. Outstanding water, sewer, storm water, street light, refuse and organics fees that are more than 60 days delinquent as of August 31, 2025, are placed on an assessment roll to be specially assessed, subject to public hearing by the City Council.

Mayor Sabas opened the public hearing at 6:31 p.m.

No comments made.

Motion

Motion by Councilmember Moe and seconded by Councilmember LaCroix to close the public hearing at 6:31 p.m. Voting in favor were Mayor Sabas, Councilmembers Tesdall, Moe, Truesdell and LaCroix. Voting against: none. Motion carried.

Resolution 2025-51

Councilmember Truesdell introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

Resolution Adopting the Assessment Roll for the Goose Lake Parkway and Elm Creek Trail Area, Improvement Project No. 22502

City Engineer Nelson stated that on September 22, 2025, the City Council approved a resolution declaring the project costs to be assessed and ordered the Assessment Hearing for the Goose Lake Parkway and Elm Creek Trail Area, Improvement Project No. 22502.

Construction Manager Morse stated that improvements included street reconstruction with spot curb replacement of broken or sunken curb sections. Improvements were made to the sidewalks, ADA pedestrian ramps (where required), trail reconstruction, storm sewer and drain tile installation, streetlight wiring, sanitary sewer improvements, water main gate valve replacements, and sign replacements, as necessary.

City Engineer Nelson provided additional details related to project costs and the proposed assessment.

Public Hearing

Mayor Sabas opened the public hearing at 6:46 p.m.

Daniel Burns, 11631 Magnolia Court, stated that he has lived in Champlin for nearly four decades, noting the tax dollars that he has paid during that time, and asked why those funds are not being used for the improvement project.

Finance Director Johnson explained how the City portion of property taxes are used, noting additional funds that are used towards large projects such as street reconstruction projects.

Mr. Burns was unsure how the tax dollars he has paid over the last four decades would not have been sufficient to cover this assessment cost. He believed that road projects should be covered within the City budget.

Mayor Sabas noted the other City services that are paid using the property tax dollars. He noted that some cities use assessments to contribute towards road projects, while other cities increase their levies to cover that cost within their budgets. He noted that the assessment is only a portion of the cost, in this case, 36 percent, while the remainder of the project cost is covered through the tax dollars.

Mr. Burns commented that he and his wife are on social security as their only source of income and asked what would happen if they did not pay the assessment.

The City Engineer replied that the amount would be added to the property taxes each year for the term of repayment.

Mr. Burns commented that the improvement was needed, but he is disappointed in the assessment.

City Engineer Nelson noted that there is an application for deferment that can be explored with the Finance Director. She provided additional information on the burden of road improvement projects within the community, noting that the City has 100 miles of roadway to manage.

Mayor Sabas noted that the City only receives a portion of the property taxes paid by residents. He noted that the City is very cognizant of how tax dollars are spent.

Ricardo Faure, 11533 Pondview Court N, presented an objection to the project cost assessment.

The City Attorney asked and received confirmation that the resident is submitting a formal objection to the assessment.

Mayor Sabas encouraged the resident to reach out to their real estate agent/broker, as the project was disclosed to residents in that neighborhood about one year ago.

Motion

Motion by Councilmember Moe and seconded by Councilmember Tesdall to close the public hearing at 7:00 p.m. Voting in favor were Mayor Sabas, Councilmembers Tesdall, Moe, Truesdell and LaCroix. Voting against: none. Motion carried.

Councilmember Moe noted that submission of the written objection is just the first step and asked that staff provide a contact for the resident to follow up with.

The City Attorney stated that staff can provide that follow-up information on the statute.

Mayor Sabas reiterated that the resident should reach out to their real estate agent/broker, as those costs should have been disclosed and paid for by the seller.

Councilmember Tesdall commented that the Council often hears a story similar to Mr. Burns' each time there is an assessment, which leads to a discussion of whether the process should be changed. She stated that she has always been a proponent that the road projects should be covered within the City budget but recognized the high cost to do so and the increase in taxes that would occur in order to support that increase to the budget. She also noted the issue of fairness for those who have already paid assessments and will continue to do so, while also paying the higher tax rate to support the change going forward.

Mayor Sabas recognized how quickly Champlin developed, which means many of the roads need repair at the same time. He stated that this Council has focused on infrastructure with a focus on those items having a longer life expectancy.

The Community Development Director stated that outstanding code violations, grass/weed and abatement fees are placed on an assessment roll subject to a public hearing by the City Council. He noted that payment was received on two items that will then be removed from the assessment roll and provided those details.

Unfinished Business

Community Development Director Schulte noted that this is a continuation of the request from the September 22nd meeting, where the Council tabled the item in order to have further discussion. Staff's opinion remains unchanged and recommends denial of both requests, noting that additional background information can be found within the packet.

Mayor Sabas noted that the Council did have a discussion on this item at the worksession earlier in the night. He stated that the Council is going to continue to discuss potential amendments to the allowed garage size/accessory structures. He noted that the Council has discussed garage size variances a number of times over the years, and therefore, is something they would like to address.

Councilmember Truesdell asked the applicant for information on their construction timeline, whether they would begin this fall or in the spring.

Councilmember Tesdall asked if the variance hardship could be that the ordinance is currently under review.

Community Development Director Schulte stated that during the worksession, the Council discussed a few scenarios that could provide relief and additional square footage for the lot that could relieve the need for a variance. He recognized the time to review and approve an ordinance amendment.

Mayor Sabas asked if the ten percent rule could be approved by the City Council tonight, and the remainder of the changes would follow the standard ordinance amendment process. It was noted changing the ordinance would not be allowed at this meeting. Mayor Sabas asked legal counsel for input on the variance request.

The City Attorney stated that staff's recommendation is based on the current ordinance, although the Council is looking to amend that current ordinance. He noted that the applicant has waived the 60-day review period and recognized that there will be additional time for the process to be completed for an ordinance amendment.

Mayor Sabas stated that the Council is looking to make changes to the ordinance to allow the applicant's request to move forward, but it would most likely not occur until the last week of November.

Councilmember Tesdall commented that the Council wants to make the ordinance more flexible for requests like this that check all the boxes.

Resolution

Councilmember Tesdall introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

A Resolution Approving a Variance and Conditional Use Permit for a Garage Exceeding 1,000 Square Feet at 1213 Independence Avenue N (Craig Butler)

The motion for the adoption of the resolution was duly seconded by Councilmember Truesdell.

Further discussion: Councilmember Truesdell noted the uniqueness of this property, where the garage will have no impact on others, with the exception of the roofline continuing along the fence line.

Councilmember LaCroix commented that findings of fact need to be specified based on the current ordinance that would substantiate hardship.

The City Attorney confirmed that there would need to be findings before the City Council could move on this action.

Community Development Director Schulte referenced page 170 of the packet, which lists the practical difficulties criteria.

Councilmember Moe stated that when the Council reviewed this at a previous meeting, they could not find a hardship and therefore requested to review and potentially amend the ordinance to create more flexibility. He believed that they would need to complete the ordinance amendment, as he would have a hard time finding a hardship in this case. He asked that the City take the additional time to complete the amendment process.

Councilmember Tesdall noted the increasing costs for materials if there is a delay in the process. She stated that the Council has creatively found hardships in the past and believed they could do so again in this case.

Mayor Sabas recognized that this will be a delay, but they are moving as quickly as possible in order to move the amendment forward. He stated that he supports the garage, as does the Council, and they are following the necessary process to allow that. He recognized that the delay would create a larger delay with winter conditions approaching.

Councilmember LaCroix stated that he supports the ordinance amendment, and this project would fit into that. He agreed that the current Code is too restrictive and was apologetic that they cannot move quicker than this.

Councilmember Tesdall withdrew her motion.

Motion by Councilmember Tesdall and seconded by Councilmember Moe to continue consideration of this item to allow the ordinance amendment to move forward. Voting in favor were Mayor Sabas, Councilmembers Tesdall, Moe, Truesdell and LaCroix. Voting against: none. Motion carried.
